This year is the 150th anniversary of the birth of Frank Lloyd Wright, one of the most influential American architects of the 20th century. His ideas can be seen all around us in buildings that emphasize open floor plans, large glass windows which allow views of the outdoors, fireplaces that center common areas, back yards treated as sanctuaries and horizontal roof pitches which allow the sky to pour in. Wright had a highly developed way of making a building seem just like a part of its site.


