A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Last week Mary Pat and I along with the Drapers and Gregorys attended the Ministers and Mates Retreat in Orange Beach, Alabama. It was a wonderful experience except for the weather.

Every day the beach was covered with fog. You could not even see the Gulf of Mexico from the shoreline and it was this fog that reminded me of a story.

Picture a man stumbling along in a heavy fog, totally lost, but then way off in the distance, he sees a light from one small lamp.

There is not enough light to burn off the fog, nor enough light to illuminate all the obstacles that might be on the ground between the man and that lamp. But something causes him to believe if he heads toward that lamp he will be going in the right direction. That "something" we will call Faith.

While heading toward the lamp he finds another lost person
