Dear Valley,

It made so much sense to us to name our daughter after these extraordinary women that any other possibilities quickly faded into the ether. From before she was born, our daughter was Sadie Lou, and I could not imagine Carrie and I giving her any other name.

Such was the case for our decision to accept the call you have voted to issue. Doing so made so much sense to us that any other possibilities had long since faded into non-options. The Holy Spirit has made it abundantly clear to us that Valley and Birmingham are where we are next meant to be, and following the Spirit's lead in this instance has been as clear to us as what to name our daughter.

There will surely be speed bumps along our walk together, and obstacles to overcome and paths to agree to embark upon together. Those moments will take holy and sacred work from each of us, and especially so given the collective moment we are all experiencing amid a global pandemic. But I am prepared to journey through those moments with you, and to help create consensus around how we continue rising to this collective moment in the name of God incarnated in Jesus Christ.

Carrie, Sadie, and I are excited to soon make Birmingham our next hometown, and Valley our next home church. As we begin our sojourn eastward, I am in prayer for you, and I hope to see you soon. Christ's and yours, Pastor Eric
