

Dear Friend in Christ,

I am happy to share with you my first sermon for 2021, on the occasion of the Baptism of the Lord. This Sunday, we will be reading Matthew's account of Christ's baptism by His cousin John the Baptist, because Matthew includes a detail the other Gospel accounts do not: that John initially objected to baptizing Jesus, feeling that their roles should be reversed with Jesus baptizing him. But Jesus persuaded John to consent to baptizing Him, and John did so. Jesus did not force or guilt John into baptizing Him, but sought John's willingness. And Jesus in turn seeks our own willingness to follow Him when He comes to us.
