I am happy to share with you this Sunday the third and final installment of our three-part sermon series on Josiah, the final righteous king of Judah, in the 600s BCE. We have spent the past two weeks reading about Josiah's discovery of the Torah scroll and its authentication by the prophetess Huldah; now, we spend today reading about the fruits of Josiah's religious reforms before his untimely death in battle at Megiddo against the invading Pharaoh of Egypt, Neco. Josiah's life was cut short, but his zealously pro-YHWH legacy loomed large over Judah in its waning decades, and it remains instructive to us still today.
