In April 1951, members of Birmingham First Christian Church, with the church's blessing, planted Valley as the latest of a few Disciples of Christ congregations in the Birmingham area. This Sunday, we will finish the series with the Bible passage that gave the series its name: when Jesus instructs us to forgive others "seventy times seven" which literally adds up to 490 but really means forgiving people in their totality. We are celebrating the totality of Valley—our past *and* our future—and I look forward to finishing that celebration with you.
